Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

200 AREA EFFLUENT TREATMENT FACILITY

1. STATUS OF SCHEDULE/DESIGN/CONSTRUCTION

Mr. J. Coenenberg (WHC) introduced Mr. B. Julian (Ecology) as the new unit manager for 200 ETF, LERF and 242-A Evaporator.

Mr. S. Godfrey (WHC) provided the status of the schedule for design and construction. Construction is 99 percent complete. The items remaining to be completed include coating and crack repairs, instrument tagging and labeling, additional concrete work, and the collection system. Final site preparation, which is divided into two phases, is in Phase 2. The forecast for completion of all construction is May 1995, with the exception of the surge tank.

Mr. Godfrey stated that the surge tank collapsed during an ATP. Approximately 8,000 gallons had been pumped while the vent system was closed, which caused the tank to collapse under the vacuum that was created. Mr. Godfrey indicated that there were no spills, no injuries, and no related equipment damage resulting from the collapsed tank. Adtech has inspected the tank and is developing a repair plan. WHC has estimated the repair will occur in mid-June 1995. The impact to the schedule is unknown.

Regarding the acceptance test procedures (ATPs), 62 of 64 ATPs have been completed. The remaining two ATPs involve the secondary treatment train and the fire protection, and they are scheduled for completion this Friday (4-14-95).

The revised program baseline change has been submitted to RL for approval. WHC is statusing the schedule and working on the basis of the revised baseline.

2. PROGRAM STATUS

Mr. Coenberg initiated a discussion regarding the permitting process. The Part B permit applications for 200 ETF, LERF, and 242-A Evaporator are being combined. The workshops for revising the Part B permit applications for consolidation are scheduled to begin in September 1995. There has been discussion whether the three Part A permit applications should be combined or maintained separately. Mr. Coenberg noted that maintaining separate Part A permit applications would facilitate the closure process of a particular portion of a facility.

Mr. D. Flyckt (WHC) raised two topics for discussion. The first topic was with regard to establishing the surveillance procedure for the special protective coating (SPC) on the secondary containment. Mr. Flyckt requested Mr. Julian's input on the development of the procedure. Mr. Julian stated that Ecology is preparing a letter to DOE-RL pertaining to the inspection criteria for the SPC. Mr. Julian and Mr. Flyckt agreed to further discuss the issue.

The second issue raised by Mr. Flyckt was with regard to interim status requirements for the facility during revision of the Part B permit application. Mr. Julian responded that he would provide a definitive answer after discussion with his management.

3. GENERAL DISCUSSION

There were no items for general discussion.

4. ACTION ITEMS

There were no action items to status.

LIQUID EFFLUENT RETENTION FACILITY**1. PROGRAM STATUS**

A brief discussion regarding land disposal issues (LDR) was held during the M-17 Unit Managers Meeting previous to this meeting. Mr. Julian indicated the LDR issue should not pose a problem for the LERF Facility.

2. GENERAL DISCUSSION

There were no topics for general discussion.

3. ACTION ITEMS

There were no action items to status.

242-A EVAPORATOR**1. PROGRAM STATUS**

Mr. B. Von Bargen (WHC) provided an update on the program status. The facility is still in the outage preparing for campaign 95-1, which is scheduled for June 1, 1995. The new condensate recycle system has been installed, and no problems have been encountered during testing of the system. WHC has been receiving and evaluating sample data for Tanks 106-AP and 107-AP. The data quality objectives and subsequent documentation for the 242-A Evaporator have been revised and are in review. The water training run is expected to be initiated within the next week.

2. GENERAL DISCUSSION

Ms. M. Selby (Ecology) provided a status of the 216 Permit. The permit is in DOE-RL review and is scheduled for public comment May 1, 1995. The public hearing is scheduled May 30, 1995.

3. ACTION ITEMS

There were no action items to status.

4. SET NEXT MEETING DATE

It was agreed to hold the Unit Manager Meetings bi-monthly, and the next meeting was scheduled for June 15, 1995, at 2:30 p.m. in Richland, Washington.
