This letter transmits the subject documents in compliance with Section 9.2 of the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order (Tri-Party Agreement). The Proposed Plan evaluates remedial alternatives and proposes a remedy for the 100-FR-1, 100-FR-2, 100-FR-3, 100-IU-2, and 100-IU-6 Operable Units under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act. The Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study provides information supporting the Proposed Plan.

These are primary documents as described in Section 9.2 of the Tri-Party Agreement. The Draft A Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study and Proposed Plan were submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and State of Washington Department of Ecology for review on December 19, 2012, by letter 13-AMRP-0050, in compliance with Tri-Party Agreement Milestone M-015-00D. The U.S. Department of Energy Richland Operations Office has worked closely with EPA to incorporate comments and revise the documents. Several updates to the Proposed Plan were also provided in a collaborative effort to resolve EPA's comments. The attached documents incorporate resolution of these comments and consider Hanford Advisory Board advice and Tribal input. These documents will support the formal public comment process currently planned for June 9 through August 11, 2014, which incorporates a 30 day extension based on early stakeholder requests.


