
This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

**Description of current waste site condition:**

The 90 day accumulation area was a fenced and locked area located in the 200 East Pipe Laydown Area, which is on the north side of the 200 East Area. All remaining waste has been removed. Closure of the 90-day accumulation area was conducted to meet the closure performance standards of WAC 173-303-610 (2). All personnel interviewed for the closure plan indicated that to their direct or indirect knowledge, no leaks or breaches of the 17 drums staged at this accumulation area occurred. RL letter 02-RCA-029, dated Oct 30 2001, transmitting closure certification for the 200 East Area Pipe Laydown Yard Accumulation Area.

**Basis for reclassification:**

There were no documented spills in the unit. All dangerous waste and dangerous waste residues have been verified to have been removed from the accumulation area; thus, the site has been closed in compliance with WAC 173-303-630(10).
