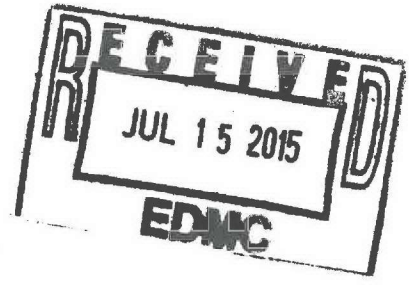
(What is the current physical state of the site? What activities have been performed?)

The 300-25 waste site is synonymous with the 324 Chemical and Materials Engineering Laboratory and is located within the 300-FF-2 Operable Unit. The 300-25 waste site was assigned to a physical structure and is not considered an unplanned release, nor does it otherwise represent contaminated media adjacent to or beneath the building. As such, the 324 Building is in process of being demolished in accordance with Action Memorandum #2 for the 300 Area and the Removal Action Work Plan (RAWP) for 300 Area Facilities, DOE/RL-2004-77, Rev. 2.

**Basis for reclassification:**

(How does the site meet the reclassification status?)

The entire 324 facility is covered by a Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 removal action and this facility does not represent a separate waste site under the TPA-MP-14 process. TPA-MP-14 Rev. 2 dated 9/1/2011 states that buildings/facilities which do not contain a TSD unit shall not be documented in WIDS. This facility contained no permitted TSD units and does not meet MP-14 criteria. Therefore, the 300-25 waste site has been reclassified as "Rejected".



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
