REQUEST FOR CONCURRENCE FOR THE INCLUSION OF WASTE SITES 100-D-5,  
100-D-46, 100-D-6, 100-D-32, AND 118-D-3 FOR REMEDIAL ACTION (RA)

Per the requirements stated in the interim action Record of Decision (ROD) for the 100-BC-1, 100-DR-1, and 100-HR-1 Operable Units, and DOE/RL-96-17, "100 Area Remedial Design Report/Remedial Action Work Plan," the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL) is planning the RA of waste sites 100-D-5, 100-D-46, 100-D-6, 100-D-32, and 100-D-3 under the provisions for "proximity sites." These sites are not specifically included in the 1995 ROD, 1997 ROD Amendment, or the 1999 Remaining Sites ROD, but are in proximity to the Group 3 D/DR small sites and pipelines.

Waste site 100-D-5 will be impacted in its entirety by the remediation of the pipelines. Waste sites 100-D-46, 100-D-6, 100-D-32, and 118-D-3 will only be partially impacted by the remediation of the small sites and the pipelines. RL is requesting concurrence from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency and the State of Washington Department of Ecology for the inclusion of these waste sites for RA.
