




Tri-Party Agreement

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HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT ORDER (HFFACO) EXTENSION OF DISPUTE AT THE INTER-AGENCY MANAGEMENT INTEGRATION TEAM (IAMIT) LEVEL ON THE REGULATOR COMMENT VERSION OF THE 221-U FACILITY RD/RA WORK PLAN FROM MAY 30, 2008, 2008 TO JUNE 20, 2008

Per Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order Article XVI, Resolution of Disputes, section N, the IAMIT agrees to extend the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement (HFFACO) dispute on the regulator comment version of the 221-U Facility remedial design remedial action (RD/RA) work plan from May 30, 2008 to June ~~30~~, 2008. The extension is required to allow the IAMIT additional time to evaluate and discuss the statement of dispute on the regulator comments for the 221-U Facility (RD/RA) work plan. The U. S. Department of Energy initiated dispute in the RL to EPA letter, 08-AMCP-0127, INITIATION OF DISPUTE RESOLUTION FOR HFFACO 221-U FACILITY REMEDIAL DESIGN/REMEDIAL ACTION (RD/RA) WORK PLAN, on March 3, 2008 and transmitted a statement of dispute on March 27, 2008. The dispute had been extended until May 30, 2008 and is being extended to JUNE 20, 2008 at the IAMIT level.
