The 89,000 acres of land on the Wahluke Slope and adjacent areas of the Hanford Reach, it's anticipated the land will go mostly to farms. Some to each of the other interests, Indians for digging roots, Archaeology Digs, Hunting & Fishing, Wildlife and some will be wetlands after the water is applied to the land.

In the proposal to Congress, the authorization we have to show that farmers are willing to commit for additional areas, many new farmers, crops for export. Each one understands that development costs and delivery systems for this land have to be paid for. At the present time, according to the loan agreement on the land, each acre was committed for the \$131.60. Added facilities at today's costs will be much higher, however, it is payable over a 50 year period. The land costs are undetermined but estimated at approximately \$1,500.00 per acre.

For testimony to Congress, we have to have commitments for the majority of the land by interested and financially capable people and firms.

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
