The 2607-ER system includes a septic tank and a trench type drain field. The tank has two access ports and is surrounded by light post and chain labeled "2607-ER Sanitary Septic Tank".

In 1996, the flow exceed the drainfield design capacity. The system was abandoned in 1997 in accordance with Washington Administrative Code 246-272-18501. Facilities serviced by this system were connected to a regional system.
