I am pleased to send you a copy of the March 1999 report, BNFL-RPT-001 Rev. 0, "Organic Analysis of AW-101 and AN-107 Tank Waste." This report documents analyses for VOA, SVOA, PCB, Pesticide, Dioxin, Furan, etc.

Although BNFL and its contractors did not run organic analyses specifically to fulfil the "Regulatory Data Quality Objectives (DQO) Supporting Tank Waste Remediation System Privatization Project," (PNNL-12040), many of BNFL's analyses are identical to those requested in the DQO.

Please consider this an informal transmittal for Ecology's information. As discussed today over the telephone, I have glanced over the data and did not find any surprises. I would like DOE and Ecology to jointly consider what the wisest choice of action would be as far as further analysis to the Privatization Regulatory DQO.
