The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued alternative text with additional comments to your office under cover letter dated December 20, 1993. This letter further requested the comments be incorporated into the above referenced documents and that the revised documents be transmitted to us within thirty days. 33769

To date, Ecology and EPA have neither received the documents, nor have we received a request to extend the due date for receipt of the revised documents. As you are aware, these are considered primary documents under the terms of the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order, and as such are subject to specific time frames for review. Your office has, as of January 22, 1994, exceeded the time frame prescribed for comment incorporation of a primary document. This is a violation of both the spirit and the terms and conditions of the Consent Order. Please provide the documents within three days of receipt of this correspondence.
