Hello Jill -

1) Primary technical concerns for the 100-D/H Area are:

- The Proposed Plan does not include treatment for strontium-90 in groundwater and does not include treatment of nitrate in groundwater as part of the planned pump-and-treat system for hexavalent chromium.
- The Proposed Plan includes use of institutional controls at 47 waste sites for between 15 and 186 years to prevent exposure to residual contamination that will be left in place.
- Tribal exposure scenarios were not considered during development of cleanup levels (also applies to other River Corridor Operable Units); which may result in higher exposure for individuals to engage in traditional practices in the 100-D/H Area.
- The acceptable risk level for residual radionuclides in the 100-D/H Operable Unit is 1×10^{-4} ; considerably higher than the 1×10^{-6} that would be allowed under MTCA. This allows greater levels of residual contamination to remain in place (also applies to other River Corridor Operable Units).

We didn't touch on all of these directly, but our conversation covered some of this and other key issues like point of compliance for contaminants to the Columbia River.

Please refer to Rose Ferri's handout for the cultural (process) issues.


