1. Approval of Past UMM Minutes

The May 1994 Unit Managers' Meeting minutes were approved and signed.

2. Status Action Items

Action item 02-23-94:2, WHC (F. A. Ruck) will set up a meeting with the appropriate people from the groundwater section of WHC and Ecology. This action item was left open. Ms. J. J. Wallace (Ecology) suggested setting up the meeting during the second week of June 1994. Modified

3. Status Closure Activities

Part A

Transition

F. A. Ruck (WHC) reported that a letter is being drafted agreeing with Ms. J. J. Wallace's (Ecology) request for a change in the boundaries to include the entire B-3-3 ditch and the stabilized west end of B-Pond in the Part A permit application. A map showing the revised boundary will be included. R. K. Tranter (WHC) will include text in the work plan that will delineate the boundary.

## Interim Stabilization Activities

A. K. McDowell (WHC) and D. E. Jackson (WHC) gave a presentation on Liquid Level Monitoring frequency requirements. Presently a daily drive-by inspection is being conducted of C Lobe for freeboard. Because of the great percolation capacity of C Lobe, the water does not register on the two liquid level stakes and hasn't for the last two years. Mr. Jackson presented an analysis of 40 CFR 265, Subpart K, adopted in WAC 173-303, which would allow Ecology to grant relief from the daily inspections. J. J. Wallace (Ecology) agreed that it did not seem that daily inspections would continue to be necessary. Ecology requested that a letter be issued which would outline the requested relief.

D. L. Smith (WHC) reported that the Main Pond should be dry by mid-August. All pipes leading to B-Pond are isolated except one 3" pipe that is not actively discharging. It will be isolated soon. The entire area is well marked and mapped. The ditch will be marked with underground marking post.

## Revision 1 Closure Plan

NOD comments from Ecology were received on June 9, 1994. RCRA Closures is reviewing the comments. A schedule is being developed to review the comments, perform issue resolution, and revise the document.

J. J. Wallace committed to a July 11, 1994 date to review chapter 5 and return numbered comments.

## RCRA Closure/RCRA Past Practice Integration Activities

The Agreement form is signed off by everyone except Paul Beaver (EPA). The work plan should be transmitted to DOE by July 11, 1994. It should be to Ecology by July 15, 1994.
