






Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

1. PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

The October 4, 1995, Unit Managers Meeting minutes were approved by Ecology and WHC. The minutes will be delivered to Mr. C. Clark (RL) for signature.

2. PROGRAM STATUS

Mr. B. Barnes (WHC) inquired about the letter received from Ecology on the Response Action Plan. Following a discussion of the calculations contained in the letter, the participants agreed that a technical meeting on this topic was in order. The technical meeting to discuss the Response Action Plan engineering technology will be scheduled within the next month, with a followup meeting in the spring. The purpose of the followup meeting will be to discuss the results of leachate data collected during the winter. Mr. N. Hepner (Ecology) committed to writing a letter to approving the Response Action Plan in order to close out an operational readiness requirement.

Mr. Barnes informed Mr. Hepner that after checking the applicable regulations, he did not find provisions in the regulations that state a response action leakage rate is dependent on climate. Mr. Hepner stated that during his review of the EPA guidance document on developing a response action plan, he did not find guidelines indicating the action leakage rate was dependent on climate. Mr. Barnes asked Mr. Hepner if the current response action plan met the EPA guidance document and Mr. Hepner responded that it did.

3. PERMIT APPLICATION STATUS

• Part B Notice of Deficiency (NOD) Workshop Schedule

Ms. G. Cummins (WHC) handed out a Hanford Facility Permit LLBG Draft Part B Proposed Workshop Schedule (Attachment 5). The first NOD workshop will follow the Unit Managers Meeting to discuss the remaining issues and the schedule and approach. Ms. Cummins further stated that a draft of the LLBG Part A, Form 3, revision is not yet available; however, one will be forwarded to Mr. Hepner

before the next meeting. Ms. Cummins requested that if there are any proposed changes to the schedule, to let her know.

4. RCRA TOPICS

There were no comments.

5. GENERAL TOPICS

- **Status of Pump and Treat**

Mr. R. Mercer (WHC) provided an update on the pump and treat operation being managed by Bechtel Hanford, Inc. (BHI). Mr. Mercer stated that BHI has not started drilling the monitoring wells.

- **Past Action Items**

Action item 10-27-93:1, schedule a technical issues meeting for RCRA/CERCLA integration and discussion of pump and treat evaluations.

WHC is continuing to provide pump and treat information to Ecology. This action item was left open.

Action item 10-04-95:1, RL/WHC will provide Ecology a portion or all of the Part B permit application for review by the first week of November 1995.

This action item was closed.

- **New Action Items**

A technical meeting will be scheduled to discuss the Response Action Plan engineering technology within the next month.

Ecology will write a letter approving the Response Action Plan.

6. SCHEDULE NEXT MEETING

- **Tentative Date**

The next Unit Managers Meeting was scheduled for December 6, 1995. A NOD workshop will follow the Unit Managers Meeting.

- **Proposed Topics**

Proposed topics for discussion include: (1) the Part A, Form 3 revision, to reach resolution; and (2) the NOD Response letter written to address Ecology's letter received in June 1995.
