## Notice of Application for State Permit 200 Area Treated Effluent Disposal Facility on the Hanford Site

Washington State Department of Ecology invites public comment regarding an application for a wastewater discharge permit by the U.S. Department of Energy

Washington State Department of Ecology has received a permit application from the U.S. Department of Energy for the discharge to the soil of treated wastewater from seven existing facilities in the Hanford Site's 200 East and West Areas. The discharge site will be about 25 miles northwest of Richland. The Ecology department tentatively proposes to issue the permit and proceed with permit development. A draft permit is scheduled for public comment and review in early 1995.

**Public Comment:** The Ecology department seeks to learn issues of public concern about the application. Interested persons are encouraged to submit comments at this time for the draft fact sheet to be issued in the first quarter of 1995 with the draft permit. Any person, upon request, will receive subsequent mailings regarding this permit.
