HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT ORDER (TRI-PARTY AGREEMENT) CHANGE REQUEST M-016-02-04, "ADDITIONAL EXTRACTION WELL AND MONITORING WELL FOR 100-KR-4 PUMP-AND-TREAT SYSTEM"

The U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and the State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) continued discussions on Tri-Party Agreement Change Request M-016-02-04, Additional Extraction Well and Monitoring Well for 100-KR-4 Pump and Treat System. As a result of these discussions, the change package was revised and is enclosed for your approval. The parties believe that the revised change package represents a mutually acceptable set of actions for the 100-KR-4 Pump and Treat System. In accordance with the Tri-Party Agreement Action Plan, Section 12.0, Changes to the Agreement, the parties have 14 days following receipt of a signed change package to disposition the change package.

RL welcomes the opportunity to continue discussions on the proposed change package and workscope and believes that the path forward for this system is appropriate.


