



- 1) Approval of September 20, 2017 Meeting Minutes (Ecology/PNSO/PNNL) – Minutes for the September 20, 2017, meeting was signed by PNNL and PNSO; the minutes will be processed through Ecology and returned to PNNL to complete.

- 2) Discussion Items:
 - a) 325 HWTUs Quarterly Permit Modifications (PNSO/PNNL)
 - Boundary Change (on hold). – The last update was that the Corps of Engineers were working on the verification of markers.
 - Contingency Plan Update – The Contingency Plan is currently in the queue with Ecology.

 - b) Hanford RCRA Permit Revision 9 Development (Ecology/PNSO/PNNL)
 - Status of CAPs In Development – Ecology has finished the WAP CAP and held an internal workshop. The Permitting team will work to have all the deficiencies rolled into a database. This will allow a visual for what the common issues were. With the reviews internally, with legal, etc., the timeframe is looking to be around two months.

Process information is on hold due to key a player out on medical leave.

Ecology is working on finishing up review of the 325HWTUs Building Emergency Plan.

The CAPs for Training, Part A, and Security, have been provided to the permittees.

- Status of Security Addendum for 325 HWTUs – The verbiage for the Security Addendum for 325 HWTUs was agreed upon during the January 10, 2018, meeting, 325 HWTUs Security Workshop.

- Schedule for Next Unit-Specific Workshop – 325 HWTUs – Ecology will need to transmit the deficiencies to PNNL/PNSO prior to being able to schedule the workshops. Ecology will target for a date near February 14,
