I. Approval of November 29, 2007 Liquid Processing and Capsule Storage Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH). The PMM minutes were approved.

II. Operational Status

LIQUID EFFLUENT RETENTION FACILITY (LERF)

Waste Inventory (1/1/2008)

- Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 14.8 ft or 4.1 Mgal
- Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 18.4 ft or 5.7 Mgal
- Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 10.4 ft or 2.5 Mgal

Received 47 tanker shipments, TX/TY groundwater and UP-1 groundwater during December

- Basin 44 received ~7,000 gallons* of leachate from the mixed waste burial trenches in 1 tanker
- Basins 42 and 44 received ~23,000 gallons* of purgewater in 46 tankers
- Basin 43 received groundwater at ~59 gpm from TX/TY and UP-1 groundwater (1/1/2008)

EFFLUENT TREATMENT FACILITY (ETF)

- Treated Basin 43 and GW IX regeneration wastewater (~2.0 Mgal)
- Completed regeneration of six GW IX resin totes; discussion of additional regeneration activities pending

200 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (TEDF)

- Receiving wastewater at ~20 gpm (based on 1/1/2008 144-hour flow)

300 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (310 TEDF)

- Receiving wastewater at 67 gpm average December flow

340 COMPLEX

- Nothing to report

* estimated volume is determined by multiplying the number of tankers received by a previously established tanker volume value that varies by tanker type

III. Project Specific Issues

A. Status of Dangerous Waste Permit Revisions

1. Tony Miskho (FH) reported that the groundwater permit conditions are in review and comment. The closure addendum has been provided to Ecology. FH is reviewing and providing comments on the up-front conditions to be consistent with PNNL (331-C) and CH2M Hill's (242-A Evaporator) comments. Mr. Miskho noted that at the permit board meeting there was a lengthy discussion regarding the differences in the emergency plan documents for Fluor, CH2M Hill and PNNL. CH2M Hill indicated a willingness at the board meeting to consider following Fluor's procedure.
2. Mr. Miskho reported that RL sent a letter to Ecology stating that the analytical methods for groundwater monitoring in the LERF permit need updating. Ecology indicated it will be sending a letter requesting that RL submit a permit modification, which will cover LERF and 183-H. RL has not received the letter from Ecology, but FH continues to update the groundwater analytical method.

B. 310/340 Status

1. Linda Petersen (FH) reported there was no change in status.

C. ST4502 Permit Status

1. There was no change in status.

D. ST4500 Permit Status

1. There was no change in status.

E. LERF

1. LERF was covered under agenda item 3A. It was agreed to remove this agenda item, since it is already covered.

IV. General Discussions

1. Deborah Singleton (Ecology) stated that Rick Bond will be the new project manager for LPCS.

V. Status of Actions (report attached)

- A. 1129 - Finalize LERF permit conditions for Ecology approval. Ecology, RL/FH and EPA met in December 2007 and January 2008, and the permittees are updating documents.

VI. New Action Items

- A. There were no new action items.

VII. Documents for submittal to the Administrative Record

- A. The December 6, 2007 letter from RL to Ecology stating that the analytical methods for groundwater monitoring in the LERF permit need updating.
