**MODIFY APPENDIX C OF THE HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND
CONSENT ORDER (TRI-PARTY AGREEMENT)**

Appendix C of the Tri-Party Agreement lists Hanford Site waste sites that potentially require remediation. When the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the State of Washington Department of Ecology, hereinafter referred to as the Parties, first negotiated the Hanford Site cleanup program, the waste sites were divided into operable units (OU) based primarily on the presence or absence of Resource Conservation and Recovery Act treatment, storage, or disposal facilities within the OU.

Operational records indicated that the West Lake site (216-N-8) did not receive cooling water discharge and is not appropriate for the 200-CW-1 OU. Based on the intermittent nature of the waste site, the West Lake site is more appropriate in the 200-UR-1 OU and not the 200-CW-1 OU.

The enclosed Tri-Party Agreement Change Request, C-04-01, formalizes this change and has been reviewed with John Price, of your staff. In accordance with Tri-Party Agreement Action Plan, Section 12.0, Changes to the Agreement, the Parties have 14 days following receipt of a signed change package to act on the change package.





Description/Justification of Change:				
<p>Appendix C of the Tri-Party Agreement lists Hanford waste sites that potentially require remediation. When the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the State of Washington Department of Ecology, hereinafter referred to as the Parties, first negotiated the Hanford Site cleanup program, the waste sites were divided into OUs. OU groupings were based on the likely response scenarios including both sampling and analysis and remedial action. OU groupings were revised as the likely response scenarios changed. Each OU (and the waste sites contained therein) was defined as either a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Past Practice Site or a Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act Past Practice Site based primarily on the presence or absence of RCRA treatment, storage, or disposal facilities within the OU.</p> <p>Operational records indicated that the West Lake site (216-N-8) did not receive cooling water discharge and is not appropriate for the 200-CW-1 OU. Based on the intermittent nature of the waste site, the West Lake site is more appropriate in the 200-UR-1 OU and not the 200-CW-1 OU.</p> <p>Modifications/deletions to Appendix C are included as pages 2 and 3 of this Tri-Party Agreement change package and are denoted using redline/strikeout; additions are denoted with shading.</p>
