This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

The 2607-EK Septic Tank is a reinforced concrete tank surrounded by a chain and labeled 2607-EK. The associated drainfield is east of the tank. The drainfield is comprised of eleven parallel runs of 15 centimeter (6 inch) perforated drain pipe. The runs are 27 meters (90 feet) long and spaced 2.4 meters (8 feet) apart.

Basis for reclassification:

In 1996, Project L-218 installed a new regional system to replace many of the systems located along Baltimore Avenue in the 200 East Area. The 2607-EK system was abandoned in 1997 in accordance with Washington Administrative Code 246-272-18501.
