

This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

In 1975, previously buried waste in the 218-W-4A Burial Ground was exposed to the surface due to soil erosion. Shortly after the exposed waste was discovered, the area was covered with 6 inches (15.24 centimeters) of sand, a layer of urea bore, a layer of 10-mil plastic, 12 to 14 inches (30.5 to 35.6 centimeters) of dirt, and 3 to 4 inches (7.6 to 10.2 centimeters) of rock.

Basis for reclassification:

It is recommended UPR-200-W-72 be reclassified to Reject (Consolidated). The release occurred within the foot print of the 218-W-4A Burial Ground. Remedial actions done at the 218-W-4A Burial Ground will also account for the UPR-200-W-72 release.
