This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

The site is an open pit, partially filled with tumbleweeds and surrounded with metal fence posts and a broken light chain. A shallow 10-centimeter (4-inch) steel pipe enters the pit from the north. Little visual evidence of coal dust remains in the pit.

Basis for reclassification:

Analytical assays of coal ash piles have found no evidence to indicate hazardous, dangerous, corrosive, or radioactive waste exists at coal ash sites. If the coal contained hazardous contaminants/ characteristics they would be present in the ash. Since the ash doesn't test as hazardous waste it can be concluded that the coal is not hazardous.
