

BURIAL GROUND SAMPLING AND ANALYSIS PLAN RESULTS FOR JANUARY
THROUGH MARCH 2007

The purpose of this letter is to notify the State of Washington Department of Ecology that there were no Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order (Tri-Party Agreement) Milestone M-91-40 sampling and analysis activities conducted during the January through March 2007 quarter. Under Tri-Party Agreement Milestone M-91-40, requirement 2, paragraph 3, quarterly reports of results from retrieval burial grounds Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) sampling activities are required. Since there were no sampling and analysis activities conducted for Burial Grounds 218-W-4B, 218-W-4C, 218-E-12B, and 218-W-3A during this quarter, no analysis results for those burial grounds are provided for this reporting period.
