"COMPLETE TREATMENT OF DRUMMED WASTE FROM 618-4 BURIAL GROUND"**

The U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL) is pleased to inform you that the final shipment of treated uranium-chips-in-oil waste was, on August 4, 2004, disposed in the Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility (ERDF). This activity marks the completion of Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order (Tri-Party Agreement) Interim Milestone M-016-03I, "Complete Treatment of Drummed Waste from the 618-4 Burial Ground in Accordance with an Approved Remedial Design Report/Remedial Action Work Plan." The completion date for this milestone was "to be determined (TBD)." All of the treated drums were disposed in ERDF.
