
This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

A site number for the Ground Contamination around the B-Plant Sand Filter was assigned in 1980. A correspondence from Harold Maxfield, dated September 24, 198, states UN-216-E-18 (aka UPR-200-E-90) is an operational dose rate zone established due to high gamma dose rates emitting from the 291-B Stack and sand filter area. Harold Maxfield said it was mistakenly designated as an Unplanned Release Site.

Basis for reclassification:

In 1981, it was recognized that the radiation area was posted due to dose rate issues and was mistakenly designated as an Unplanned Release site. It is recommended this site be reclassification to Rejected.
