Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

1. Approval of Past UMM Minutes (Ecology/RL/EPA/WHC):

The June 22, and July 20, 1994, Unit Managers' Meeting Minutes were signed by the Ecology Unit Manager. The signature of the RL unit manager during this period will be obtained after this meeting.

2. Status Action Items:

3. Status Closure Activities:

A representative from WHC Geophysics (J. P. Kiessler) explained that the signal from a canister as small as 1 pint or 1 quart would be very small on a 1 meter survey grid. Mr. Kiessler went on to explain that since the subsurface soils at the firing ranges are not free of anomalous debris, e.g., variations in soil terrain, rocks, and spent bullets and cartridges, therefore the signal would be even harder to detect. Mr. Kiessler stated that if a geophysical survey was performed that it would take approximately 200 person-hours to conduct the survey and analyze the data. At this point each anomalous reading would have to be "ground truthed". Ground truthing would required that every anomalous reading be excavated to determine if it was the napalm canister. Due to the limitations of the GPR survey and the fact that the canister was not encountered during soil sampling, WHC (R.K. Bhatia) proposed that no further efforts be spent on locating the canister as part of the TSD closure. Ecology (F. MA) will contact their technical expert on GPR surveys to determine if additional surveying would yield more information. The issue of future surveys/explorations of the napalm canister remains unresolved.

WHC (R. K. Bhatia) stated that the HPADS closure plan was out for RL/WHC review and that the Rev.1 of the closure plan and NOD table was due to Ecology by December 15, 1994.
