

BURIAL GROUND SAMPLING AND ANALYSIS RESULTS FOR APRIL-JUNE 2007

The purpose of this letter is to notify the State of Washington Department of Ecology that there were no Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order (Tri-Party Agreement) Milestone M-91-40 sampling and analysis activities conducted during April through June 2007. Tri-Party Agreement Milestone M-91-40, Requirement 2, Paragraph 3, requires quarterly reports of results from retrieval burial grounds Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) sampling activities. Since there were no sampling and analysis activities conducted under Tri-Party Agreement Milestone M-91-40 SAPs for Burial Grounds 218-W-4B, 218-W-4C, 218-E-12B, or 218-W-3A during the April-June quarter, no analysis results for those burial grounds are provided for this reporting period.
