for the Immobilized High-Level Waste Interim Storage and Completion of Hanford

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) received the U.S. Department of Energy's (USDOE) Dangerous Waste Permit Application, Part A, Form 3, Revision 0, for the Immobilized High-Level Waste Interim Storage Unit (IHLW), dated June 28, 1999, and the July 26, 1999, follow-up letter.
