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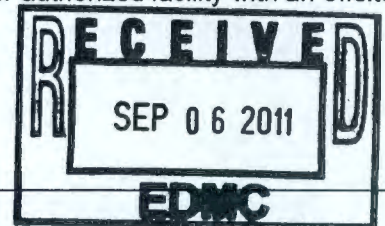

Description of Change:
Waste Management Plan additions to the Removal Action Work Plan

E. M. Mattlin DOE and F. R. Bond Lead Regulatory Agency agree that the proposed change modifies an approved workplan/document and will be processed in accordance with the Tri-Party Agreement Action Plan, Section 9.0, *Documentation and Records*, and not Chapter 12.0, *Changes to the Agreement*.

- Page iii – Delete WMP from Acronym list
- Page 2-7 – in section 2.3.5 delete the phrase “in accordance with DOE/RL 2005-16, *PFP Above Grade Structures Waste Management Plan* (DOE/RL 2005c).” and replace it with “applicable ARARs specified in table 4-1.”
- Page 4-6 – section 4.2 end of first paragraph delete “and the PFP Waste Management Plan (WMP) (DOE/RL 2005c)” and add “reflected in section 4.1 of this RAWP.”
- Page 4-7 - Change the first sentence in 4.2.3 from “The CERCLA Removal Action Area of Contamination and On-site Area are described in the PFP WMP (DOE/RL 2005c).” and replace with “The CERCLA Removal Action Area of Contamination are the buildings listed in Table 1-1 of this RAWP and the On-site Area for the action is the area around the structures listed in Table 1-1 including the entire area enclosed by the exterior PFP perimeter fence and staging areas set up outside the PFP perimeter fence (e.g. 212-Z).
- Page 4-7 – Insert in section 4.2.4 after the words “... will be managed by PFP” the word “under the Deactivation RAWP (DOE/RL 2005a).”
- Page 4-7 -- section 4.2.6 Change to read “Any TRU waste that is generated will be packaged for shipment to WIPP; all other regulated waste will be shipped to the ERDF for disposal or other authorized facility with an offsite determination by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).”
- Page 6-2 – Delete Reference DOE/RL 2005c

Justification and Impacts of Change:

The proposed changes incorporate all substantive elements from the stand alone waste management plan (DOE/RL-205-16) into the removal action work plan Facility Deactivation as is the current documentation practices. The action will clarify applicable requirements, reduce redundancy and reduce unnecessary administrative burden associated with multiple documents. Applicable waste management practices are identified in section 4.2.
