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LES DAVENPORT: Hi, I'm Les Davenport. I would like to give my comments and question earlier on 618-10, 618-11 burial grounds into the formal record. It is my opinion that the stimulus funds which will be used for characterizing the 618-10 burial grounds is a good use of the money. I would also like to see characterization of the 618-11 burial ground done as quickly as possible. It will result, I think, in the ability to clean up the waste trenches in both sites without much of any problem.

However, the vertical pipe units, and particularly the caissons in the 618-11, will take considerable characterization and work to make sure that any remote handle transuranic waste is properly encapsulated, moved and stored so that it eventually can be dealt with. Thank you again.
