Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

1. Approval of Past Unit Managers Meeting Minutes

The February 13, 1995 Unit Manager Meeting minutes were approved by Ecology. DOE-RL approval is being deferred to next month.

2. Analytical Results Status

• Solid Waste Barrel and Legacy Equipment Results

Mr. W. Slater (PNL) noted that the validated data was informally transmitted to Ms. G. Davis (Ecology), and PNL is waiting for Ecology's acceptance of the data before concluding hazardous waste is not contained in the barrel. Ms. Davis stated that Mr. A. Stone (Ecology) is reviewing the data.

• Transmittal Letter

PNL is preparing a letter for RL to formally transmit the validated data to Ecology.

3. Hanford Facility Permit Modification Status

Ms. Davis stated that no public comments have been received regarding the Hanford Facility Permit Modification public hearing held February 1, 1995. Ms. Davis stated that until Ecology meets internally to review RL/PNL's comment on the closure schedule (reducing the 180 days to 60 days), she would not provide concurrence.

PNL will provide Ecology the status of the pipe break in the 1234 yard.

● Old Action Items

Action item 01-13-95:1, PNL will provide Ecology the matrix spike, matrix spike duplicate data. Ms. Davis stated that Ecology received the data. This action item was closed.

Ms. Davis inquired about the status of the pipe break in the 1234 yard where the SHLWS unit is located. Mr. W. Slater (PNL) agreed to provide the status.

6. Next Unit Managers Meeting

The next Unit Managers Meeting was scheduled for April 20, 1995, at 1 p.m. Ecology, RL and PNL agreed to discuss the need for scheduling future Unit Manager Meetings at that time. Topics for discussion will include a status of Ecology's review of the validated data, a status regarding certification of the closure plan, and the Hanford Facility Permit modification status.
