

I. Approval of July 24, 2008 T Plant Complex Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH). The PMM minutes were approved.

II. Operational Status

- Mixed Waste Received (includes inter-facility transfers)
38.3 M3 184 55-gallon drum equivalents
CWC - 184
- Mixed Waste Transferred Onsite
52.02 M3 259 55-gallon drum equivalents
WRAP - 250
- Mixed Waste Shipped Offsite
0.00 M3 0 55-gallon drum equivalents
- TRU Mixed Waste Repackaging
 - Repackaged one hundred and thirty-one (131) 55-gallon drums of TRU mixed waste into one hundred and ninety-six (196) 55-gallon drums to meet WIPP compliance.
- Washington Department of Health Inspection
 - On Tuesday, July 15, 2008, WDOH conducted an EPA Level II inspection of the 291-T Stack. Immediate feedback was that records and equipment "looked good." *Inspection report received on August 11, 2008 stating, "There were no formal findings or issues arising from the inspection."*
- Dangerous Waste Training Plan (DWTP) Updated
 - Per the concern noted in the March 4 2008 Notice of Violation, T Plant's DWTP was updated and approved on July 21, 2008. Per the proposed resolution, On-the-Job-Training (OJT) now has a course number and documentation of OJT is maintained.

"3) WAC 173-303-330, Personal Training

Resolution: 'Per WAC 173-303-330(1), USDOE-RL and FH must provide a program of classroom instruction or On-the-Job-Training (OJT) training for facility personnel that manage dangerous wastes. The program must be consistent with the requirements of WAC 173-303-330(2) and specify that all required training, including applicable OJT, must be documented and retained. The record of completion of the required training must be maintained in the facility's operating record. USDOE-RL and FH must revise the T Plant Dangerous Waste Training Plan as necessary to ensure that all documentation of all required training is being retained.'

RL/FH Response: T Plant's Dangerous Waste Training Plan (DWTP) is in revision to include course numbers where OJT was previously identified. Documentation of all required training will be retained for both classroom training and OJT checklists with training course numbers and will be maintained in the facility's operating record. A draft DWTP with the above revisions was distributed for review and approval on April 1, 2008, and a final DWTP is expected by July 2008."

III. Project Specific Issues

A. 221 Tank System

Paul Martin (FH) reported that a response has been prepared and will be transmitted from RL to Eric Van Mason (Ecology) regarding his questions about the tank system.

IV. General Discussions

A. Deborah Singleton (Ecology) stated that Addendums B and C, (Waste Analysis Plan and processing) for T Plant's permit are being finalized. As soon as EPA's comments are incorporated, a draft copy of Addendums B and C will be shared with RL/FH. Ecology is preparing the closure addendum as more of a schedule for conditions directing how closure will be addressed in the future, since some of the facilities will continue to operate for many years. Joel Williams (FH) reported that Mr. Van Mason was provided with an updated version of the contingency plan for T Plant.
