





- I. Approval of the May 22, 2003 LLBG Project Meeting Minutes Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)
- II. Operational Status (Dan Saueressig FH)
 - No Non-ATG Waste Accepted at Trench 34 in May
 - Waste Shipped from ATG to Trench 34 in May
Non-Thermal
MLLW 1,649 cubic feet 225 drum eqs
 - No Defueled Reactor Compartment Received in May
- III. Project Specific Issues
 - A. Part B Permit Application Status
 1. The NOD workshops are continuing. Matt Mills (Ecology) reported that he has drafted a letter granting a 180 day extension to 1/18/04. Comment resolution is in progress on Chapter 8, the WAP is being updated to include in-trench treatment and groundwater comments from PNNL have been received.
 - B. Carbon Tetrachloride Issues
 1. Continued monitoring of the three semi-permanent boreholes has not yielded any spikes in results. Dan Saueressig will provide and update on monitoring results. The Remediation Plan is in progress.
 - C. Rocky Flats/Kaiser Hill Waste
 1. Ecology has voiced an interest in following the status of the 68,000 cuM of waste forecasted in the EIS.
 - D. M-91-12A Status
 1. Fred Jamison (Ecology) reported that Pacific ECO Systems is the new owner of the ATG facilities.
- IV. General Discussions
 - A. Update on Signature Authority related to TPA driven actions
 1. The new disclaimer for the meeting minutes approval sheet was discussed and accepted.
 - B. The SEPA checklist is pending issuance of the EIS which is still in draft form. Mr. Jamison would like to see discussions coordinated during workshops and would like to tie-in RL and Ecology work with LLBG activities. Jeannette Hyatt (FH) recommended workshops be used to discuss EIS comments.
 - C. Dan Saueressig asked for some clarification regarding an Administrative Order requirement to prepare a Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) for the LLBG. There seems to be some confusion about requirements for sampling of vent risers. Ellen Mattlin (RL) requested that clarifying questions be submitted by e-mail to RL.
