


WSCF PMM Minutes for June, held on June 21, 2012 at 09:00am in the WDOE Office
Attendees: Lee Fearon, Deborah Singleton, Dan Smith, and Matt Mills

- ECO Discussion
 1. Discuss implementation for SAA's in general and any other compliance questions/issues-
 - D. Singleton and L. Fearon indicated they would like to visit WSCF in the near term.
 - Determine timeframe and specifics for visit. A site visit has been set up for Tuesday July 31, 2012 at 9am at the 6266 Building (WSCF).
 - L. Fearon requested the electronic files for the WSCF PMM Minutes from January 2012 on. M. Mills provided these files in an email on June 26, 2012.
 2. How WSCF is meeting Ecology's concerns/agreements from the September 2011 inspection-
 - D. Singleton indicated that the visit to be performed by Ecology would look at how WSCF has met Ecology's concerns/agreements from the September 2011 inspection.

 2. Mixed Waste Trenches 31 & 34 data call-
 - L. Fearon requested confirmation for Mixed Waste Trenches 31 & 34 leachate sampling frequency at the WSCF Lab.
 - M. Mills provided data on 06/06/2012 via email that WSCF had received 2 samples so far, one on Dec 12/29/11 (113560) and one on 2/1/12 (120172).
 3. Per Ecology's specific request, provided by L. Fearon, WSCF agreed to provide confirmation of Groundwater well sample receipt for each specific request.
