



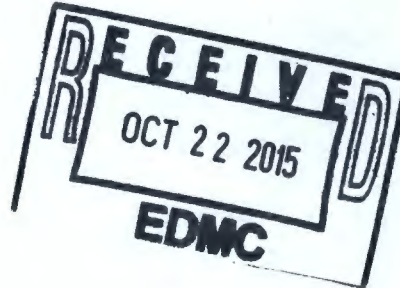

TRANSMITTAL OF CULTURAL RESOURCES REVIEW (CRR) AND FINDING OF NO ADVERSE EFFECT FOR THE 100-K AREA PUMP AND TREAT WELL REALIGNMENT IN THE 100-K AREA OF THE HANFORD SITE (HCRC# 2015-100-014)

The U.S. Department of Energy Richland Operations Office (RL) is transmitting the referenced CRR for your review and comment. The Area of Potential Effect (APE) was transmitted to your office and Tribes on June 24, 2015. Dr. Whitlam concurred with the APE on August 20, 2015, (Log No. 082015-17-DOE). The APE was surveyed on July 16, 2015. No archaeological materials were observed within any portion of the APE. Copies of correspondence on the project are included in section 10.1 of the report.

The project includes installation, maintenance, and removal of High Density Polyethylene conveyance lines, cable and placement of an above grade crossing on an existing road to optimize the remediation in the KX Pump and Treat system in the 100-K Area. The APE is partially within a known traditional cultural property.

RL has reached a 'No Adverse Effect' finding for this proposed project. We ask for your review of the enclosed information and a written response regarding RL's finding by November 13, 2015.
