HANFORD FACILITY RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND RECOVERY ACT PERMIT GENERAL INSPECTION SCHEDULE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022

This letter provides notification of the schedule for general inspections planned at the Hanford Facility during fiscal year (FY) 2022 as required by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit, Part II, Condition II.O, General Inspection Requirements. This permit condition requires the permittees to conduct annual inspections of the 100 Areas, 200 East Area, 200 West Area, 300 Area, 400 Area, and the Columbia River shoreline. These annual inspections are in addition to the treatment, storage, and disposal unit inspections specified in Parts III, V, and/or VI of the RCRA Permit.

The visual inspections are performed to identify potential malfunctions, deterioration, operator errors, and discharges that may cause or lead to the release of dangerous waste constituents to the environment or threaten human health. Specific items to be noted include, but are not limited to, remains of waste containers, container labels, or other waste management equipment; solid waste disposal sites not previously identified for corrective action; uncontrolled waste containers (e.g., orphan drums); temporary or permanent activities that could generate an uncontrolled waste form; and unpermitted waste discharges.

The following table identifies the tentative schedule for the RCRA Permit general inspections during FY 2022. The tentative schedule is subject to change based on the availability of the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and Hanford Site Contractor inspection support staff.

April 4-5, 2022	RCRA Permit Annual General Inspection of 200 East Area
May 2-3, 2022	RCRA Permit Annual General Inspection of 200 West Area
June 6-7, 2022	RCRA Permit Annual General Inspection of 100, 300, and 400 Areas
September 12-13, 2022	RCRA Permit Annual General Inspection of Columbia River Shoreline

The DOE, Hanford Mission Integration Solutions, LLC, Mission Assurance (HMIS-MA), along with representatives from other Hanford Contractors responsible for and/or knowledgeable of the areas being inspected, will conduct the general inspections. Pursuant to the provisions of the RCRA Permit, Condition II.O.1.d, HMIS-MA will notify the Washington State Department of Ecology by electronic mail at least seven (7) days prior to each general inspection to address specific details and/or any changes to the tentative schedule contained herein.
