#### **Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements**

##### **1. Workshop Process**

- **Approval of past workshop minutes**

The September 14, 2000 meeting minutes are being circulated for approval.

##### **2. Part A Issues and Permitting History of the Burial Grounds**

At this time Ecology has not agreed to changing the name of the LLBG to MWDU.

#### **Process Design Capacity and Boundary Issues**

- **Boundary Changes/RCRA Islands**

A continuing discussion was held on “RCRA islands” (e.g. 218-W-3A, 218-W-3AE) and that Ecology (Matt Mills) was still of the opinion that these islands should remain in the treatment, storage, and/or disposal (TSD) boundary of the LLBG Part A, Form 3. Mr. Mills did not feel comfortable at this time removing those burial grounds from the LLBG TSD boundary as shown in Revision 9 of the Part A, Form 3. However Mr. Mills was still looking into minimizing the impact of keeping the current TSD boundary and still meeting the needs of RL for future disposal of waste.

Mr. Mills also relayed a concern that Appendix B of the TPA listed the burial grounds with the RCRA islands as part of the TSD unit and felt that he could not remove them from the TSD boundary without going through closure and he noted that the burial grounds were listed in a “SW-2” document. This document supposedly listed these burial grounds for corrective action. At the time RL/FH was not sure what a “SW-2” document was but took an action to find out what the “SW-2” document was and to review the TPA and discuss this at the next workshop.

- **Process Design Capacity**

Ecology (Matt Mills and Steve Lijek) requested more time to review the process design capacity of 174 hectare-meters to understand the approval that Ecology made in Revision 9. Ecology took the action to review this process design capacity.

Mr. Mills and Mr. Lijek asked approximately how much onsite and offsite waste is forecasted to be received on the Hanford Site for disposal at the LLBG. RL (Todd Shrader) stated that he did not know but took an action to find out for the next meeting.

- Future Use/Permitting

Matt Mills (Ecology) had taken an action to look into permitting activities and future use (future trenches) at other hazardous waste landfills in the region, specifically the one located near Roosevelt. Mr. Mills reported that he could not find another similar TSD unit that has a permit allowing for future expansion of trenches so the LLBG is unique in this aspect. Mr. Mills decided that another course of action would be pursued during the workshops and closed out this action.

  - 3) Todd Shrader (RL) took an action to provide future onsite and offsite waste forecast for next meeting
