



- I. Approval of November 30, 2000 WESF Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)**
- II. Operational Status**
 - A. The Waste Analysis Plan and Closure Plan have been completed and have been placed in the regulatory file at WESF.**
 - B. WESF is in the process of replacing a deep well pump.**
- III. Project Specific Issues**
 - A. Fred Jamison of Ecology is tentatively scheduled to tour WESF the third week in January, 2001.**
 - B. Ecology's approval date for the extension of corrective measure #3 in the WESF NOC is January 26, 2001.**

- I. Approval of November 30, 2000 T Plant Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)
- II. Operational Status
 - A. **Production Activities 11/1 thru 11/30)**
 - 40 TRU drums head space gas sampled
 - 1 MW box RTR verified
 - 17 LLW boxes RTR verified
 - Received 40 TRU drums from CWC
 - Received 4 LLW boxes from PFP
 - Received 12 LLW boxes from various generators
 - Received 1 MW drum from 209E
 - Received 1 MW drum from WRAP
 - Received 2 MW boxes from CWC a
 - Received 6 LLW boxes from the LLBG
 - Shipped 60 TRU drums to CWC
 - Shipped 8 MW boxes to CWC
 - Shipped 6 LLW canyon waste packages to LLBG
 - Shipped 4 LLW containers were returned to Stanford
 - B. **Operational Activities**
 - Work on Canyon deck clean off continues
 - Work on the Tunnel continues (e.g., widening road, electrical work, etc.,)
 - Work continues on preparing 2706-T for sampling the 2714-U containers
- III. Project Specific Issues
 - A. 2714-U Drums - FH reported that significantly more sample bottles have been found in the 2714-U drums than anticipated, thus affecting the original schedule provided to Ecology.
- IV. General Discussions
 - A. M-91 Strategic Discussion – Discussions to resolve the dispute on M-91 continued between RL, FH and Ecology. RL and FH have been presenting the Waste Management strategic plan to Ecology and incorporating feedback. The intent is to use the results of the strategic plan to resolve the dispute.
 - B. TRU SAP – Processing of the 2714-U containers at T Plant continues to meet the requirements of the recent Ecology Notice of Corrections. Currently, LLW drums are being worked. Details of the TRU Sampling and Analysis Plan are still being finalized.

- C. Permit Workshops – A letter is being prepared for transmittal to Ecology (Greta Davis) in regards to the Draft Part A, Chapter 11.
- V. Status of Action Items
- A. SWT-00-015 (574) remains open. The action is to check on the status of the Toxicity Characteristic Leaching Procedure (TCLP) Analysis for K-Basin sludge. The analysis has not yet been finalized by Spent Nuclear Fuels.
 - B. SWT-00-017 (700) remains open. Julie Stitt (FH) and Brett Barnes (FH) will coordinate a date and time for the T Plant tour and will schedule accordingly with Fred Jamison of Ecology.
- VI. New Action Items
- A. SWT-00-018 (713) – FH accepted the action to provide the Ecology Unit Manager with an M-91 Strategic Discussion.
- VII. Next T Plant Project Meeting
