- I. Approval of the April 25, 2002 T Plant Complex Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)
- II. Operational Status (Brett Barnes FH)
 - Shipped EC-1 Condenser to Bear Creek for Recycling - NOTE: This reduced T Plant Complex's mixed waste inventory by approximately 31 cubic meters.
 - Shipped 14 K Basin low-level waste boxes to the LLBG
 - Shipped 1 low-level waste box back to the River Protection Project
 - Shipped 12 Savannah River mixed waste drums to the CWC
 - Received 18 TRU drums for head space gas sampling
 - Completed cleanout of Cells 3-L and 15-L of the 221-T Canyon in support of eventual K Basin Sludge Storage mission
 - Positioned leveling basins in Cells 3-L and 10-L for eventual K Basin Sludge Storage mission
 - Completed repairs and testing of Fan #3 of the 291-T-1
 - Continued to prepare for the PWR Fuel removal management self assessment
- III. Project Specific Issues
 - A. Greta Davis (Ecology) reported that the comments on the T Plant Complex Waste Analysis Plan (WAP) are complete. She would like to meet with FH/DOE-RL personnel to go over the comments. Jeannette Hyatt (FH) volunteered to set up a meeting early next week to meet with Ecology staff.
 - B. Brett Barnes reported that the workshops for the Dangerous Waste Permit Application, Part B, for the T Plant Complex are going well.
- IV. General Discussions
 - A. Jeannette Hyatt shared the news that T Plant Complex received an Award of Merit for participating in the Environmental Stewardship program.
 - B. Brett Barnes mentioned the contractor operational readiness review for PWR Fuel is scheduled to commence on June 3, 2002. Mr. Barnes informed Ms. Davis that this would be an excellent time to visit the T Plant Complex and observe process cell activities (e.g., cell cleanout, K Basin Sludge equipment installation).

- C. Greta Davis reported that the Washington State Attorney General's Office has concurred on the proposed closure strategy for the 221-T RCRA Tank System. The closure strategy for the 221-T RCRA Tank System is discussed in Chapter 11.0 of the Dangerous Waste Permit Application, Part B, for the T Plant Complex.

- V. Status of Actions
 - A. 826 – action remains open. September 30 still looks good for the submittal date of the Dangerous Waste Permit Application, Part B, for the T Plant Complex.

- VI. New Action Items
 - A. Jeannette Hyatt – meet with Greta Davis to discuss Ecology's comments on the WAP.

- VII. Next Project Managers Meeting
 - A. The next project meeting is scheduled for June 27, 2002.
